The services include:

- Pre-employment transition services
- Services to pursue a meaningful career and live independently
- Provide information on Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR) and Center for Independent Living (CIL) services
- Know your rights and responsibilities under these programs, Title 1 of the ADA.
 1. Issues with employer's discrimination
 2. Reasonable accommodations
- Navigate the OVR program to achieve a successful employment outcome.
- Resolve any concerns you may have with OVR and CIL

CAP services are free. CAP promotes self advocacy and are an Independent Living Advocate. CAP takes part in policy work groups such as the small business and college policy.

OVR Public Meeting & Video Conference.

Lycoming County Employment Committee is promoting the awareness and hiring of persons with disabilities. The October event has been set for October 19th. Workforce Investment Opportunity Act (WIOA). Staff recently received training on Competitive Integrated Employment which is defined as full or part-time work in competitive integrated employment setting (including customized employment, business ownership, and telecommuting), or supported employment. Competitive Integrated Employment has three components:

1. Competitive earnings
2. Integrated location

3. Opportunities for advancement

The employment outcome must satisfy the requirements of all three components to be able to be considered Competitive Integrated Employment.

- Next year Mickey would like to see PCT do a disability Awareness Simulation.

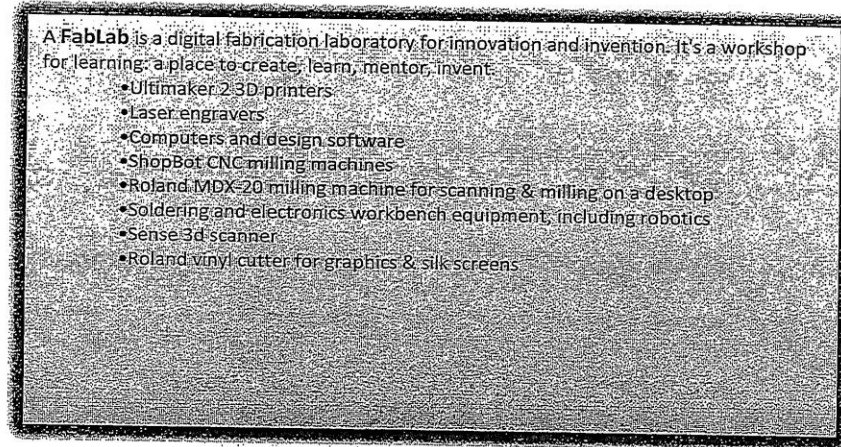
